

The Three Great Lights

An exploration of the fundamental objects of Freemasonry.

Jim Hoerricks, PhD, Archimedes Lodge #871. Lecture was Presented to Elysian Lodge on, 8/24/2023

he Three Great Lights are known around the world as the fundamental objects in Freemasonry. To the uninitiated, this bears no meaning; to a brother, a way of life. Their importance is highlighted when the Worshipful Master directs attention to the Three Great Lights during ritual exemplification.

Noted Hermeticist and Astrologer, CC Zain (Benjamin Parker Williams), noted that "the three Great Lights of Masonry, are the Bible, or Oral Law, contains in its symbolism the knowledge gained by investigating nature's laws in the remote past. The Compass and Square, or Written Law, represent the actual forces of nature. The square relates to the physical world, to the realm of effects, and the compass relates to the inner planes, the realm of causes. Together they embrace all natural law, and exemplify the Hermetic Axiom: As it is above, so it is below."

Let's explore each of these fundamental objects, beginning with the Volume of Sacred Law.

The Volume of Sacred Law

In Lodges chartered by the United Grand Lodge of England, the Worshipful Master would explain, "The most important of these (the Three Great Lights) is the Volume of the Sacred Law, an indispensable part of the Lodge. The open Bible signifies that we should regulate our conduct according to it. The teachings are to rule and guide our faith, a symbol of man's acknowledgment of his relationship to Deity." During the ceremony those assembled will be informed that "It teaches us the important duties we owe to God, to our neighbour and to ourselves." The candidate is informed that the Volume of Sacred Law is the unerring standard of **Truth** and **Justice** and that it is to rule and govern our faith.

Our oldest Masonic documents make no reference to the Bible, possibly because no part of the Bible was printed in English prior to 1525, and the first complete Bible in English was not printed until 1535. At this point in history a Bible was rarely found outside a Church. The term Volume of Sacred Law, or **VSL**, first appeared in the Old Charges in the Grand Lodge No 1 Manual Script of 1583 as an essential part of the equipment of the operative Lodge.

The **VSL** is the greatest of the **Three Great Lights**. It is considered that it pours forth **light** from the East across the Lodge. But what is **'Light'**? In Masonic culture, **'Light'** means **knowledge**. The **VSL** records the Oral Law, or the **Will of God**. From this book, the

teachings are conveyed. It symbolizes **trust**, **justice**, and **the way** in which Masons conduct their lives by the divine precepts contained therein. For hundreds of years Freemasons have applied its teachings.

What secrets do the Square and Compasses hold?

The Square

The Square is prominent throughout the rituals and ceremonies of Freemasonry and is the second of the **Great Lights**. It is normal for this implement to be displayed with the **Compasses**. During the initiation ceremony, the candidate is informed that the **Square** should remind him of his conduct in life.

The importance of the **Square** cannot be understated it is the emblem that is associated to the Master of the Lodge, "being the implement which forms the rude and proves the perfect mass, is well applied by Master Masons to inculcate the purest principles of piety and virtue. Masonically speaking, it should be the guide of all your actions" - Board of Installed Masters, UGLE.

From time immemorial the **Square** has represented **right** and **honesty**. For Freemasons, the **Square** represents **morality**. Alongside the **VSL** it reminds Freemasons that the **Grand Architect** provides instruction to man to develop his moral and spiritual character, while the **Square** reminds us that we must constantly test our behavior by the **Square**.

Freemasonry is not just about regurgitating ritual in it's ceremonies. It is **a way of life**; allowing the Mason to act by the **moral** and **ethical** code set out in ritual. Within each of us we have our own **Square** – essentially **our conscience**. We apply this in every thought, word or deed.

The Compasses

The third of the **Great Lights** is the **Compasses**. Plural? Singular? **Compass or Compasses**? The UGLE Book of Constitution, Basic Principles for Grand Lodge Recognition, in item 6 states, "That the three Great Lights of Freemasonry, (namely, the Volume of Sacred Law, the Square, and the Compasses) shall always be exhibited when the Grand Lodge or its subordinate Lodges are at work, the chief of these being the Volume of the Sacred Law." Thus, the we'll refer to them as such.

The **Compasses** are there to educate Masons in the duty we owe to ourselves. We are taught that we must keep our desires within due bounds, **circumscribing our**

desires as we practice self-reverence and self-control. Without such a restraint on our mind & deeds it could lead our lives to chaos. The restraint is needed to ensure that there is a balance between our relationship with God, our neighbor and ourselves.

The **Compasses** also act as a conduit for the mind. We hear the term 'daily advancement in **Masonic knowledge**' and the **Compasses** aids in this. Through the three **Degrees** the position of the **Compasses** on the altar changes, which represents the **progressive** nature of the instruction given in the ritual.

Diving Deeper

As with everything in Masonry, there are surface / literal meanings and there are the multiple layers of symbolism attached to the objects and lessons within the Lodge.

As above / So Below

Madrid-based author, Richard Cassaro, wrote on the symbolism of the **Square** and **Compasses**, "What secrets does it hold? What mysteries does it enshrine? The answer is, the Masonic Square & Compass relates a powerful ancient wisdom, now lost. It's the symbol of man—of you and me. More specifically, it symbolizes both our outside and inside. But what exactly does that mean, our outside and inside? It means every human being is made up of two parts. There's the part we see when we look in the mirror each day. But there's also a part that we don't see. The part you see is your body, but the part you don't see is your soul. The Square symbolizes your body, the part you see. The Compass symbolizes your soul, the part you don't see. When placed together, the Compass & Square is designed to teach us that we're more than just the body (the part we see). Deep down underneath it all, we are an eternal soul (which we don't see)."

The Three R's of the First Degree

Rules, Respect, and Repercussions

One of the lessons we learn as **leaders** is the importance of making **rules** and following through with them. This expectation setting happens early in the **initiation** process. Candidates are presented with the **rules** as well as the penalty for violating the rules. There is no ambiguity in this presentation. As such, it's a model practice for those who would **lead**.

In business, **leaders** reward people who follow the **rules** and achieve their goals and establish consequences for those who do not. Consistently communicating the benefits of staying within established guidelines versus the challenges of "driving outside of the guard rails" gives everyone the best chance to succeed in life. At home, in raising children, it's important to teach our children to **respect authority**, understand expectations, and realize that there

are **repercussions** (good and/or bad) for either meeting those expectations or not. We do our kids a disservice if we ignore the rules we set at home, because there is very little chance of that happening later in their lives.

In Lodge and in life, it is important that we clearly communicate what behaviors we expect in order to create as much positive energy as we can. As **leaders**, it's our job to make sure everyone knows what the **rules** are, how to **respect** them, and what the **repercussions** will be when the **rules** are broken. When expectations are vague and/or not communicated plainly, it creates confusion and unnecessary negative energy. Simply defining rules goes a long way towards eliminating any chance for mutual mystification.

At home, **leaders** need to teach their children how to be independent, healthy, stable adults who can function on their own. The real world certainly has rules and consequences for not following through on them. Our job is to create good **habits** while they are living at home that will continue to positively impact their lives once they are on their own.

Do you wish to proceed?


As regards the **Great Lights**, the candidate is left with clear instruction as to what's important, what's expected, and what help is available. We'll explore that help, **the working tools**, in a future discussion.
