


Brethren,

I am available two times a month at the lodge prior to our meetings for in-house tutoring on the 1st & 3rd Thursday of each month.


I'm usually at lodge most weeks and typically arrive on site at 5:00PM. If I'm there, and have no prior commitments, walking-ins may be accommodated.




