# Tidings From The West

## **T**HE APRON

Within Freemasonry, the apron carries profound symbolic meaning. Its square form, made up of four equal right angles, calls to mind the Four Cardinal Virtues: Temperance, or exercising self-restraint in what we think, say, and do; Fortitude, or showing courage in every honorable undertaking; Prudence, or choosing wisely after thoughtful reflection; and Justice, or dealing fairly and impartially with all people.

The apron's triangular flap, pointing downward, represents the Great Architect of the Universe—a Masonic expression for a Supreme Being—in three main aspects: all-seeing and all-knowing, ruling the universe with ultimate authority, and continually present in our minds and behavior. When we add the four sides of the apron to the three sides of the flap, we arrive at seven, a number that recalls the seven liberal arts and sciences that underpin Masonic teaching: Grammar, Rhetoric, Logic, Arithmetic, Geometry, Music, and Astronomy.

The strings or belt of the apron symbolize the ties of affection, faith, and confidence that bind Masons together as trusted friends and brothers.

Thus, wearing the Masonic apron continually encourages the Mason to live up to the innocence and purity it signifies and to pursue the liberal arts and sciences that have long been essential to the Masonic tradition.
